DEVONPORT'S NEW LIBRARY – HAVE YOUR SAY

The design for the re-development of the Devonport Library is now on display at the library and the council wants to know residents' opinions on the proposal.

The Devonport Heritage committee has mixed feelings on the plans. While the treatment of the Victoria Road façade works well, there were concerns about the King Edward Parade frontage. The heavy glass and concrete treatment was considered too heavy and dominant and bore little relationship with the Victoria Road side.

We acknowledge it is a difficult task to design a building that is not too over-bearing on the park and the street and also sympa-

thetic to its heritage surroundings.
